EMPOWERING REUNIFIED FAMILIES

SUPPORTING FAMILIES AFTER REUNIFICATION

Thanks to your support, by 2022 we transitioned every child from our orphanage into the care of a safe, loving family. Today, these children are growing up with a sense of belonging that was missing before.

And your generosity continues to make a difference—providing the long-term support families need to stay together and thrive.

In 2024, because of you:

- 14 families received ongoing support—including medical, dental, pastoral, educational, mental health, and social work services.
- 12,840 meals were provided to hungry families.
- 30 students attended school, from preschool to trade school.
- 5 students passed Haiti's 9th grade national exam.
- 1 student graduated from high school!

A Story of Family Support

Joselinne is on the verge of making history in her family—she will be the first to graduate from high school.

Last year, the weight of *Rheto* (her second-to-last year) felt overwhelming, and she struggled to keep up. But with determination—and the support of tutoring—she pushed through and passed.

Now in *Philo*, her final year, Joselinne is focused on graduation and the future ahead.

For her, education is more than a personal achievement. It's a beacon of hope for her younger siblings. With each lesson learned and exam passed, she is proving that perseverance and opportunity can rewrite a family's future.

EQUIPPING ORPHANAGES & SOCIAL WORKERS TO PRIORITIZE FAMILIES

GUIDING ORPHANAGES TOWARD FAMILY-BASED SOLUTIONS

Thanks to your support, we helped other Haitian orphanages take meaningful steps toward reuniting children with families. Drawing from our own firsthand experience, we offered practical, culturally relevant coaching rooted in global best practices.

This year, you helped in the following ways:

- Supported the reunification of 31 children from partner orphanages with their families through coaching and collaboration.
- Advised 5 orphanages interested in expanding their family-based care programming.
- Hosted 6 workshops on Family Reunification and Child Protection, with 94 social workers and orphanage staff participating.



Growing Demand for Coaching Services—Despite Insecurity

Insecurity in Haiti reached new heights in 2024, making travel more difficult than ever. Despite these challenges—and thanks to your support—we trained 94 social workers and orphanage staff, up from 57 the year before! This growth shows a strong and growing commitment across Haiti to improve child protection and reunification practices. Several sessions were held remotely, making it possible to reach professionals in areas otherwise cut off by violence or instability.

BRINGING THE CHURCH TO FAMILIES

REBUILDING FAMILIES WITH SPIRITUAL STRENGTH

Family restoration is about more than physical reunification—it’s about spiritual renewal too. This year, you helped bring the church into homes across Haiti through pastoral care, Bible-centered programs for children, and the introduction of a new discipleship-based parenting course called Families Count.

Families Count is a Christ-centered, church-led parenting course designed to help families heal, grow, and prepare for reunification. While originally designed for the US foster care system by Lifeline Children’s Services, we recognized the value it could have in the Haitian orphan care crisis. We received Lifeline’s permission to translate it into Creole and adapt it for use in Haiti.

Through Families Count, churches are equipped to walk alongside parents who want to bring their children back home—providing both biblical guidance and practical tools for parenting.

In 2024, because of you:

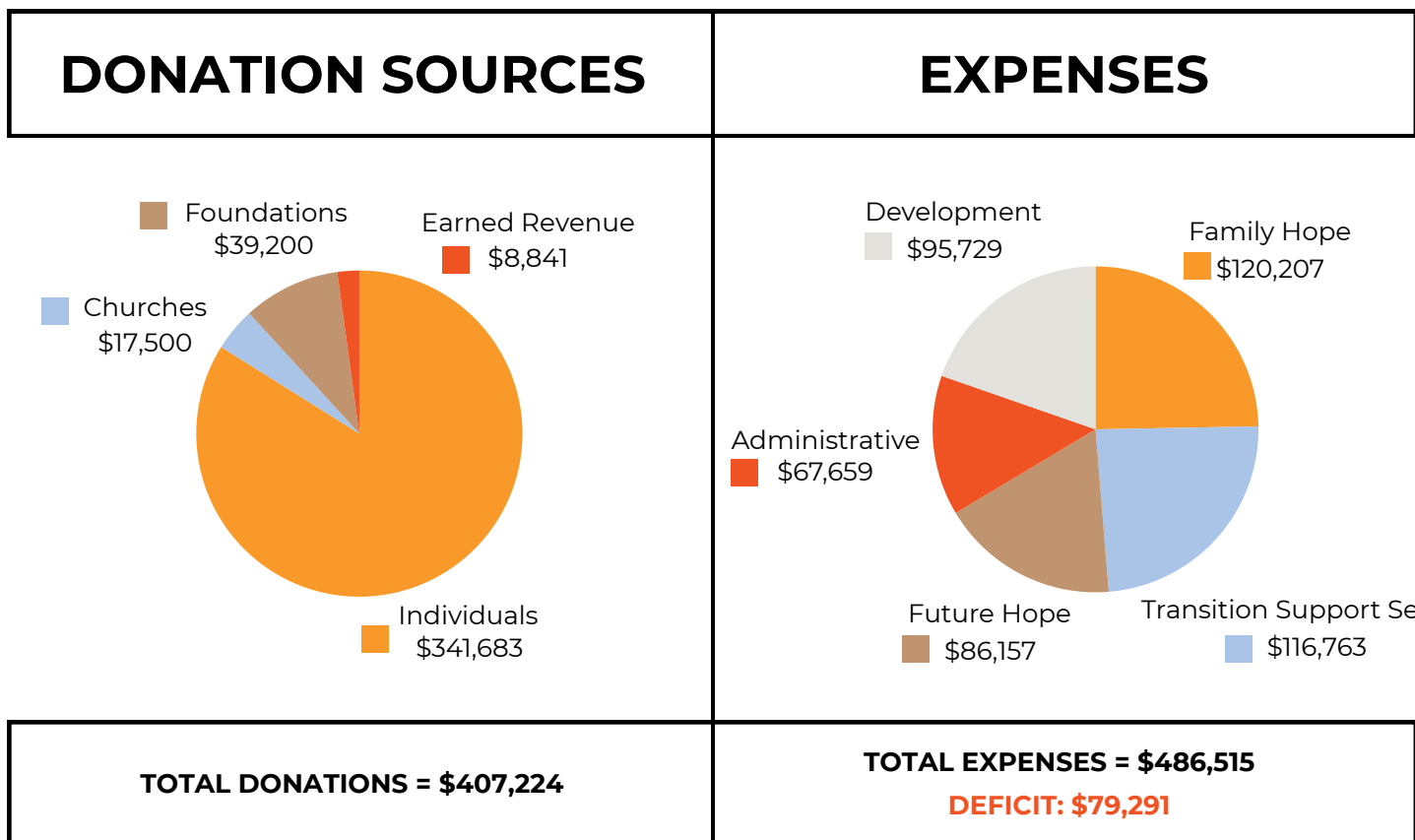
- 14 home visits were made by our staff pastor to lead devotions, pray, and offer spiritual encouragement.
- 17 children participated in a Bible memorization competition, celebrating God’s Word together.
- We translated the entire Families Count course—a Christ-centered, church-led parenting curriculum—into Haitian Creole.
- More than 100 pastors across Haiti were introduced to Families Count.
- 137 parents expressed interest in taking the Families Count course and reuniting with their children.



The Church at the Center of Family Restoration

For many Haitian parents, separation from their children has been heartbreaking—but also seemed like the only option. Through *Families Count*, churches are stepping into that pain with hope. Pastors are now equipped to offer a new path: one that leads home, rooted in God’s Word and surrounded by the local church. **One pastor said, “Thank you for this training. It will support us as we work in the community with different families. It will especially help us strengthen families in our own church.”** I am looking forward to this continuing.”

2024 FINANCIALS



Fiscal responsibility remains a core value at Child Hope. It’s what allows us to continue delivering consistent, life-changing support to children and families in Haiti—even in the face of crisis.

In 2024, we ended the year with a deficit, driven by continued instability, inflation, and escalating needs on the ground. Thanks to careful planning and the generosity of past donors, we were able to draw from reserves to meet our commitments without cutting essential services.

We recognize that volatility in Haiti will likely persist, along with the urgent needs facing vulnerable families. That’s why we’re committed to strategic growth in 2025 through the launching of the *Families Count* pilot program. With God’s provision and the faithfulness of partners like you, we will continue walking alongside our Haitian brothers and sisters.
